### MINUTES

April 12, 2018

Meeting opened by President Ruth Miller at 6:30 p.m. at Red Barn in Cle Elum, WA.

#### COMMITTEE REPORTS:

**Charity Quilts:** Elaine Joyner reported that Roberta Haire took 5 quilts to North Star in Yakima.

**Other Charity:** \$89 raised for the after school back pack program was turned in to the church.

**Quilts of Valor:** Kathy Cruse passed out magnetic lapel pins and membership cards for those who individually joined Quilts of Valor under the guild's membership. Of 45 guild members 20 joined Quilts of Valor.

#### Quilt Show:

**Vendors:** Linda Brenden advised that there should be three fabric vendors at the quilt show. She is still working on paperwork.

**Quilt Drawing:** Kathy Cruse asked that any tickets and money you have at the start of the quilt show should be turned into her then so remaining tickets can be sold at the show.

**Guild Boutique:** Celia Johnson will need us to bring items for sale when we bring in our quilts. Needed are holders for books and such.

**Volunteers:** Elaine Joyner advised that volunteers are needed for the quilt show and the guild boutique.

**Advertising:** Ruth Miller advised bookmarks and posters were mailed out.
