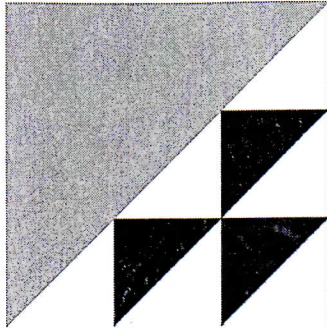


Birds in the Air



Finished size:
9" square

Materials needed: Use Civil War reproduction fabrics if possible.

One 10" square, dark

Four 4" squares background

3 4" squares of prints or solid fabrics (make sure they contrast strongly with the background fabric)

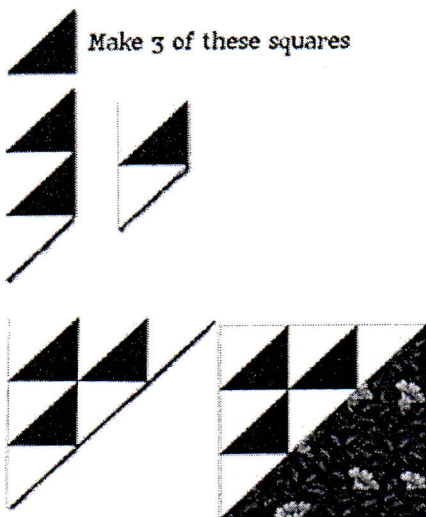
This is enough fabric to make 2 blocks.

Cutting:

Cut all pieces in half along the diagonal.

Here is the 10" square. For one block, you only need one of the triangles. Set the other aside for a second block.

Using 3 of the background squares and the 3 different colors draw a diagonal line and sew on both sides. Cut on the line and press each half square patch open. Cut the fourth background square in half on the diagonal. Assemble block as shown.
